


TUIYARUS COMMUNITY WILDLIFE

The conservancy is crisscrossed by the Trans Rift trail and the Maji Moto River—partly seasonal, partly permanent—which nourish the landscape. This natural lifeline sustains both wildlife and the people of Tuiyarus. The Maji Moto Women's Group leads local efforts in fodder production, reseeded trees, water and soil conservation, and beekeeping. Their work not only rejuvenates the ecosystem but also provides a sustainable income, ensuring that the legacy of conservation is passed on to future generations.


As a result of these efforts, animal fatalities have decreased, income from honey and fodder has risen, and the natural beauty of the land has been revived. Clean air now breathes life into the community, reducing respiratory illnesses and enhancing well-being.

Tuiyarus is also a gateway to adventure, offering eco-tourism experiences with stunning views from Kebene and Marmar hills, overlooking Lakes Baringo, Bogoria, and 94. Visitors can explore geospatial rocks, diverse wildlife, and the rich cultural history of the area while supporting sustainable development.

Overview

In the heart of Baringo County lies Tuiyarus Community Conservancy, a sanctuary born from the community's deep-rooted tradition of conservation. Established in 2018 and officially registered in 2020, the conservancy has 76 members, benefiting over 150 people. Covering 936 hectares, it stands as a beacon of community-driven environmental stewardship.

Tuiyarus takes its name from a rare medicinal shrub found only within its borders, symbolizing the community's centuries-old connection to the land. This conservancy is not only a home to wildlife such as the greater kudu, wild dogs, and the spark inch tortoise but also to vibrant cultural history, long-standing significance.
